TRACK DESCRIPTIONS

1. **Future of Interoperability & Patient Access: Identity Management Solutions to Support Patient Access to Healthcare Information**

This Track will review the challenge of patient access in the context of identity management and patient- matching, available standards that can support this need, and hear from industry innovators and the healthcare organizations that implement their technical solutions to patient engagement and monitoring through secure access.

2. **Content Interoperability**

The Content Interoperability Track will explore several new and emerging capabilities which enable and carry out interoperability. It will also update the audience on policies and standards related to interoperability.

3. **Clinician Experience & Burden Reduction**

This Track will provide an overview of the burden reduction report and current ONC strategies to reduce clinician burden and enhance clinician experience. In addition, this track will provide the opportunity to discuss how to monitor clinician burden associated with EHR use.

4. **Interoperability Infrastructure**

The Interoperability Infrastructure Track highlights efforts to further the development of the building blocks of interoperability and data exchange, including FHIR, testing tools, data models, and registries & directories.

5. **Health Information Exchange (HIE)/Community-based Information Exchange (CIE)**

The Health Information Exchange (HIE)/Community Information Exchange (CIE) Track will explore how to advance interoperability across communities and the healthcare continuum, specifically in the context of health plans, mental health, post-acute and long term care, home and community based services (HCBS), and progress in public health services coordination.
